The Prosper Fire Department reminds residents of ordinance # 00-13 of which prohibits fireworks and to encourage them to have a safe holiday weekend.

With the Fourth of July nearing us, the Prosper Fire Department wants to remind all residents of ordinance # 00-13, which prohibits the discharge of fireworks anywhere within the Town of Prosper and the ETJ (extra territorial jurisdiction) of the Town without first obtaining a permit and providing proof of a bond.

This includes any piece of property from Custer Road west over to FM 1385 and from US 380 north up to Frontier Pkwy and all property in between. The ordinance is applicable to all property within these boundaries. Town limits, ETJ, Denton County, Collin County and any property within 5000' of Town limits. If a person is found in violation of this ordinance, they may be issued a citation and if proven guilty could face a fine(s).

The Prosper Fire Department wishes everyone a safe and happy 4th of July and hopes everyone understands these restrictions are in the best interests of public safety.
