Trash Collection dates change to accommodate July 4 holiday

PROSPER (June 23, 2010) To accommodate the July 4 holiday, trash collection in Prosper will be delayed by one day. Those areas of Town which normally have trash collection service on Tuesdays will be serviced on Wednesday, July 7 and those areas of Town which normally have Friday pick-up will be serviced on Saturday, July 10. Normal collection schedule will resume the following week.

Town offices will close on July 5, but emergency services will continue. Fire, police and medical emergencies can be reported to 9-1-1 throughout the holiday weekend.

The Prosper Community Library is normally closed on Mondays.

After-hours service for utilities will be in operation at 972-347-2226.
